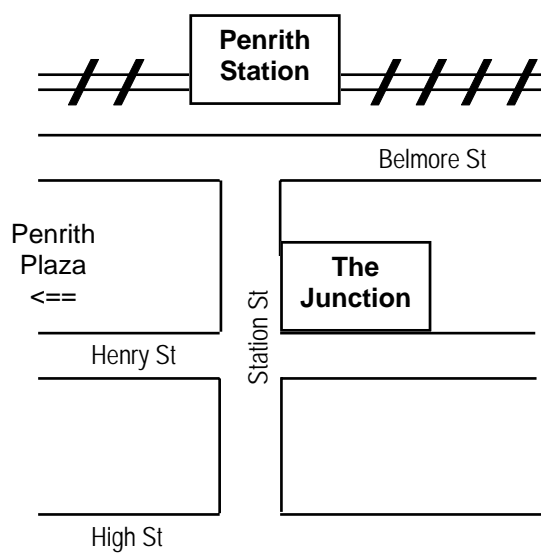

The Junction doctors understand the health needs of young people. We provide non-judgmental health care for young people under the age of 25

The following services are available:

- General Medical Care
- Contraception advice
- Pregnancy tests
- Sexual health advice
- Advice on drug problems
- Referrals to specialists
- Psychologist (Link Project)

Health 4 Employment

The Junction & Global Skills Employment Services offer a FREE confidential check up called the Youth Employment Skills (YES) Health Assessment.

Each Health Assessment will screen for health issues that may affect your ability to gain employment.

A YES Health Assessment will generally include:

- General physical health check
- Screening for health issues such as mental health or drug & alcohol problems
- Family health history
- Referral to specialised medical services or pathology if needed
